Beginning at the end of November the Library will offer downloadable eBooks from OverDrive. The eBooks will be available free, 24/7 to all Santa Monica Public Library card holders in good standing. Browse, checkout and download eBooks by visiting ebook.smpl.org. The opening day collection of eBooks was made possible by the generous support of the Friends of the Santa Monica Public Library. Downloaded titles can be enjoyed immediately on a variety of eReaders. The standard loan period is 21 days. Titles automatically expire at the end of the lending period. There are no late fees or fines.
