LIBRARY POLICY

Library Programs

Library programs are free and open to the public and are intended to promote and enhance the collections, services and mission of the Santa Monica Public Library.

In addition, a "library co-produced program" that involves community members and/or community groups will:

- Actively involve collaboration and communication with a library staff member including planning, promotion and production including library staff present at the program and evaluation.
- Introduce new topics and subjects of interest to the community and/or promote collections, services and resources.
- Possess a set duration and an established end date, unless otherwise approved by a library supervisor/manager.
- Be subject to regular evaluation and improvements by library staff.
- Be flexible and accommodate new programming and library initiatives.

Meeting rooms are available for rental for programs not co-produced by the library. Ask for information at your library.
