Byars, Betsy. **MY BROTHER, ANT**

Ant's big brother helps him get rid of the monster under the bed and other stories.

Cazet, Denys. **MINNIE AND MOO GO TO THE MOON**

Two cow friends, Minnie and Moo, decide to drive the farmer's tractor all the way to the moon. One in a series.

Cushman, Doug. **INSPECTOR HOPPER**
