Tax Forms at Santa Monica Public Library

Tax forms can be printed using the Library's mobile printing service and picked up at one of the curbside pickup locations. Go to print.smpl.org for instructions, as well as curbside pickup hours and locations.

Tax Forms Online

Paper tax forms and instructions can be ordered from the IRS and FTB websites for delivery by U.S. mail.

Tax Forms by Telephone

Tax forms can be requested by telephone:

- IRS (Internal Revenue Service): 800-829-3676 (weekdays, 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.)
- California FTB (Franchise Tax Board): 800-338-0505 (automated service, available 24/7) or 800-852-5711 (live assistance, weekdays, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.)

E-File

E-File is a fast and easy alternative to filing taxes by mail. Some filers may be eligible to file for free. File taxes electronically online by visiting:

- California FTB (Franchise Tax Board): ftb.ca.gov/file

VITA (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance)

VITA offers free tax help for those who qualify. All volunteers are IRS-certified and can assist with filing both Federal and California State income taxes online or by mail. Appointments may be made online at vita.ucla.org.

AARP Foundation Tax-Aide

AARP offers free, individualized tax preparation for low-to-moderate income taxpayers, especially those 50+, at nearly 5,000 locations nationwide. Appointments are required. Go to aarp.org/money/taxes/aarp_taxaide to find a location near you and a list of required documents to bring to your appointment.
